
Social Identity Wheel

Sexual Orientation	Heterosexual, Bisexual, Lesbian, Gay, Queer, Questioning
Religion or Spiritual Affiliation	Christian, Jewish, Muslim, Hindu, Bahai'l, Agnostic, Atheist
Socioeconomic Class	Owning class, upper class, middle class, working class, poor
Age	Young adult, middle age adult, adolescent, child, senior/elder
Gender	Man, Woman,Transgender, Gender Queer
Sex	Male, Female, Intersex
National Origin	United States, Puerto Rico, Japan, Ireland, Barbados, Dominican Republic
Physical/psychological/mental/ Learning ability	Able bodied, living with a disability, living with chronic disease
