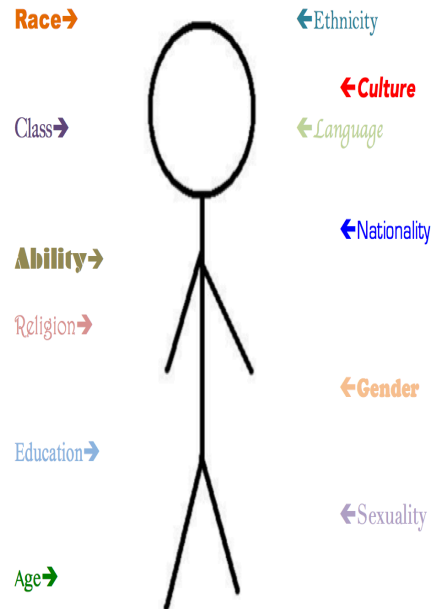


Group Activity – An Intersectional COVID Response - due 5/15 by 9pm
